Valentines Day Party – 2/14

Each classroom will be having a Valentine’s Day Party on 2/14 as part of our normal afternoon snack routine and additional time for children to distribute their cards / goodies to each other. A special snack sign up sheet will be located on the classroom doors.

Valentine Cards (Optional)

If you would like to pass out valentine cards or treats to your child’s class, we ask that you bring 24 (one for each child) and have them signed by your child. Please leave the recipient’s name blank to help the children pass out the items easier.

Health Policy Reminder

During this flu season, we would like to remind all parents of our school’s health policy to prevent the spread of any illness.

POLICY: Your child shall not be allowed to attend the Preschool for the day or will be sent home if they appear to have symptoms of illness during the day (such as acute cold symptoms, temperature of 99.7 or above, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, unusual rashes, or irritation of the eye). In such case, the parent will be notified and arrangements must be made to pick up the child immediately.

If your child has been ill, he/she may not be re-admitted to the Preschool until he/she is free of symptoms for 24 hours **without medication** or you have provided a note from your child’s physician confirming that he/she is free of symptoms.

We are continuing to sanitize our classrooms daily during this flu season and we ask for your help to keep your child at home until symptoms are no longer present and they are able to function normally in the preschool environment.
